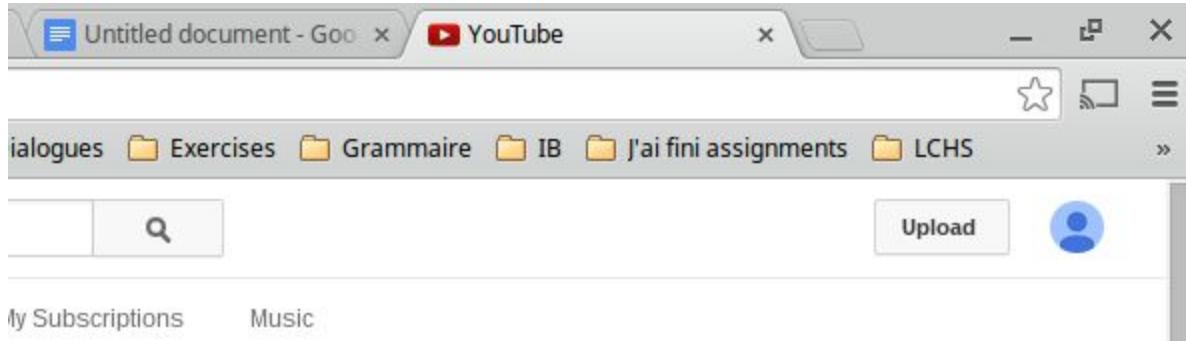
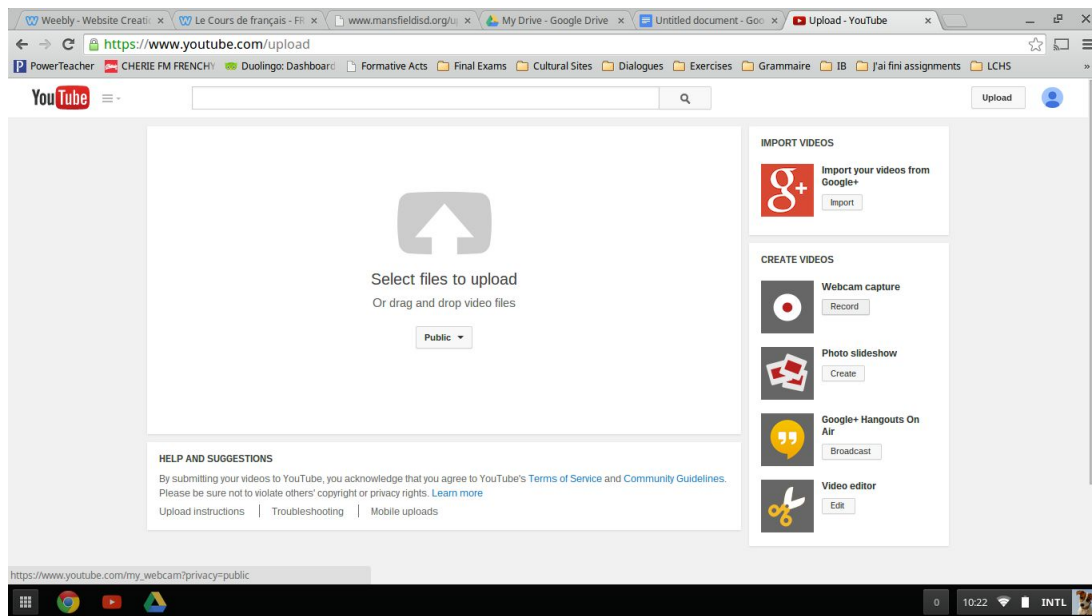


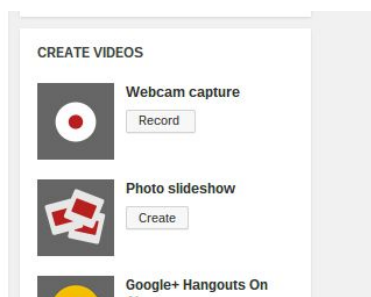
1. Go to YouTube and sign in using your personal email. **YOU CANNOT USE YOUR WAKE COUNTY EMAIL!**
2. Go to the Upload button in the top-right corner of your browser.



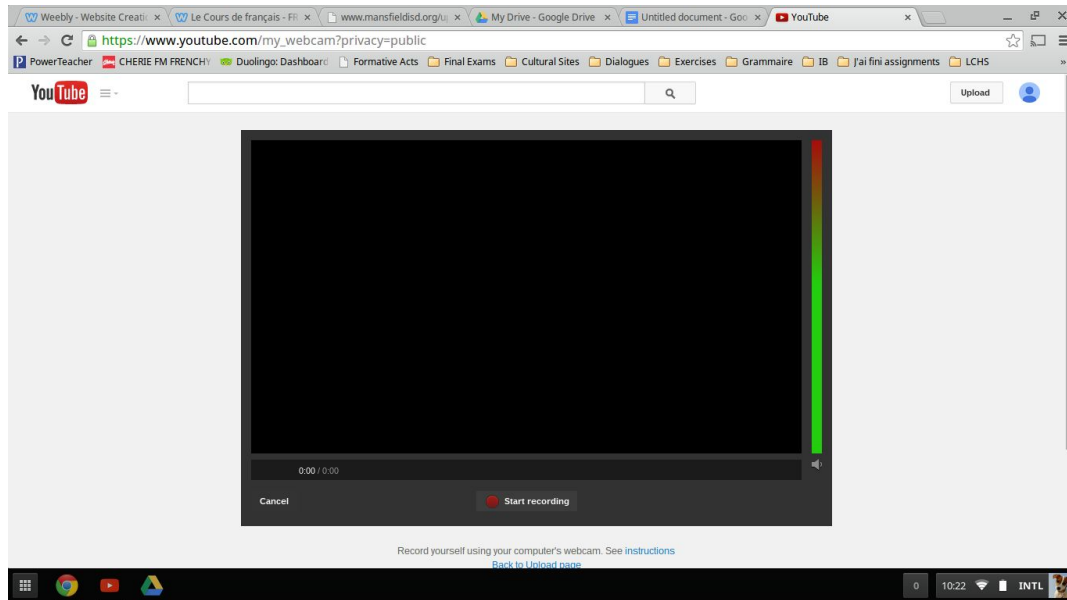
3. Select the “Webcam Capture” option on the right-hand menu.



4. Click Record



5. Select “Start Recording” at the bottom of the screen.



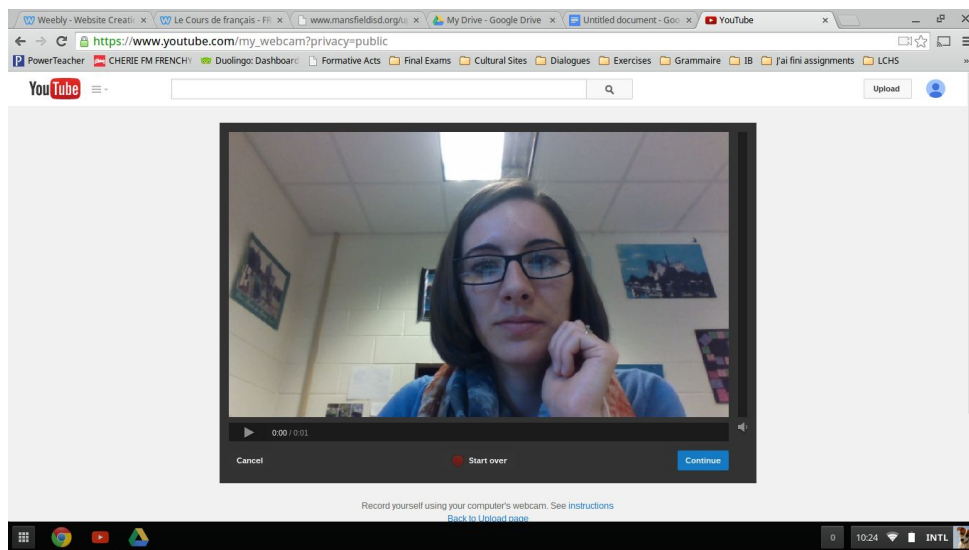
6. A pull-down menu will show up at the top of your browser window asking for access to your camera and microphone. Click “allow.”

7. Your video will begin to record. When you are finished with your video, click “Stop Recording.” If you are satisfied, select “Continue” in the bottom-right corner of the video recording area. It may take some time, so be patient as your video uploads to your YouTube page.

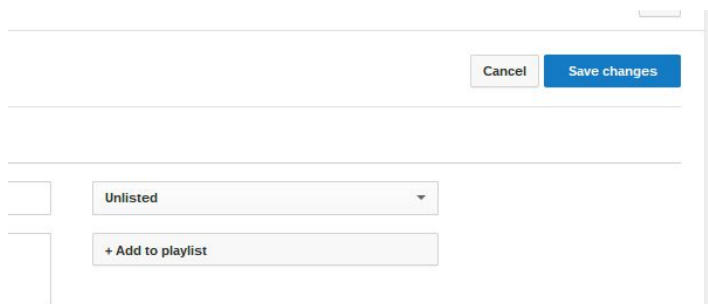
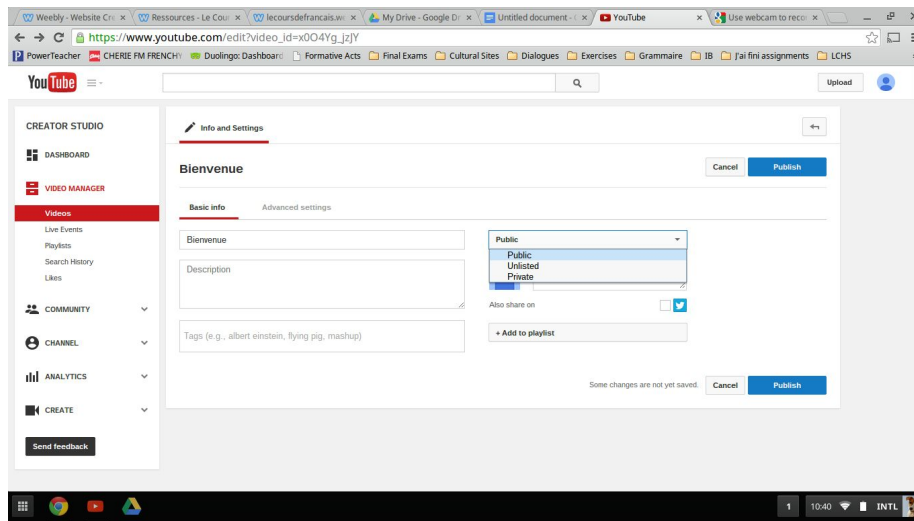
**For your first video, record the following script:**

Bonjour, je m’appelle (your name). Bienvenue à mon site! Merci! Au revoir!

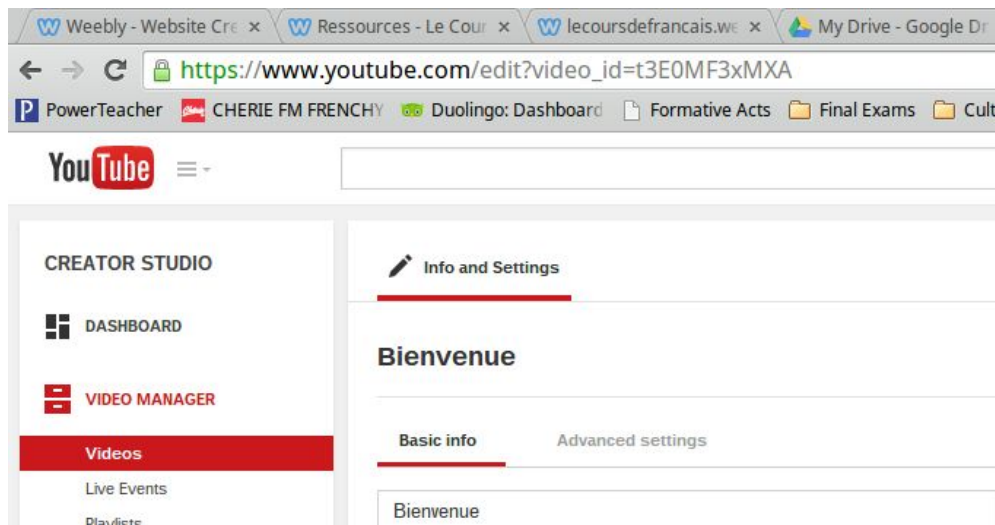


8. You can edit the title of your page in the dialog box below the bolded title. You can title your first video “Bienvenue!” Make sure to go to the drop-down menu that says “Public” and change your video to “Unlisted.”

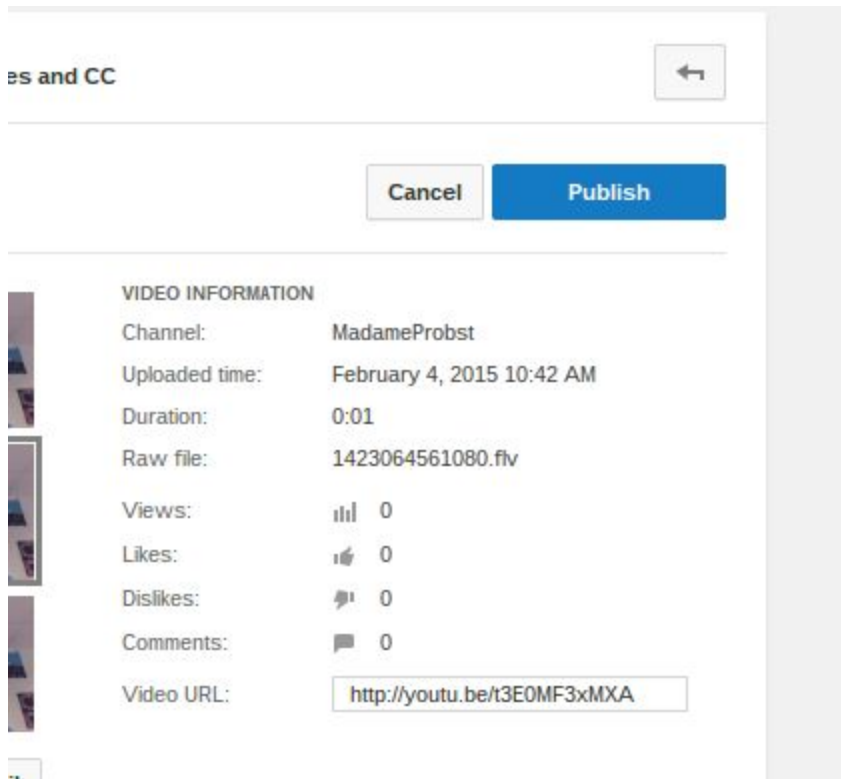
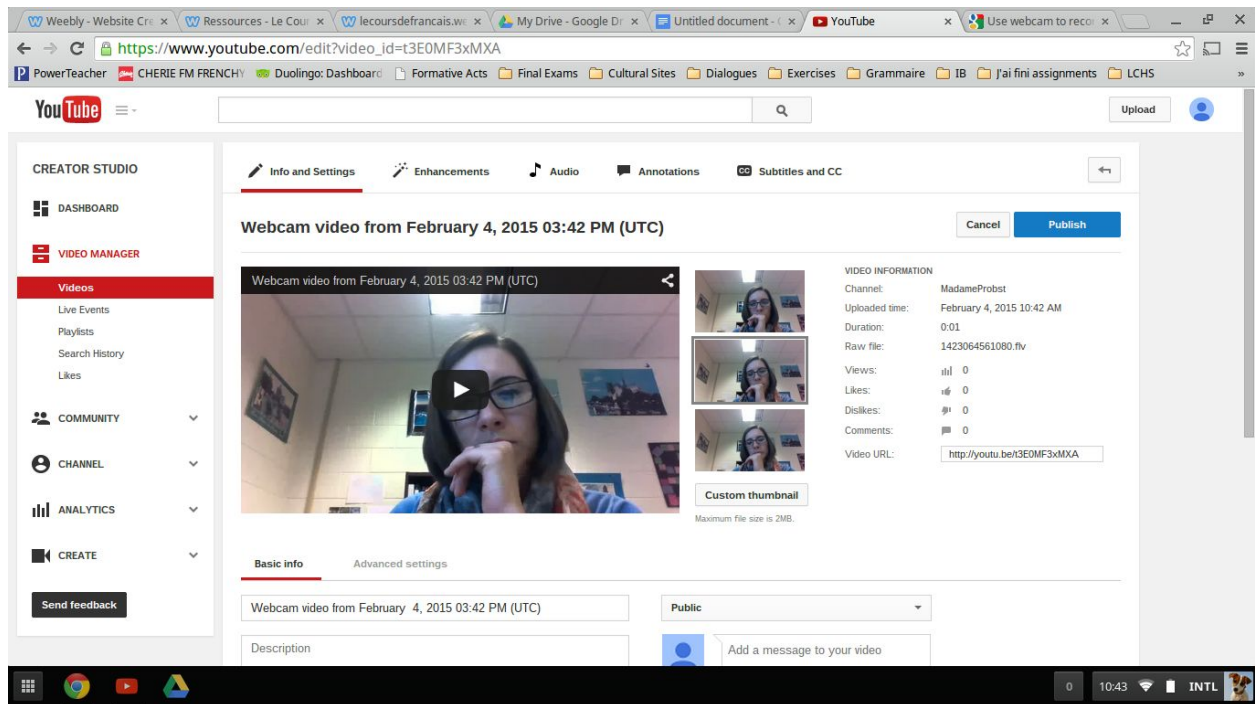


9. Select “Save changes” at the bottom- or top-right of the page.

10. To copy your video’s URL, click on “Info and Settings” in the top-left of the screen.



11. Your screen will change to look like this. You will find your Video URL in the bottom-right corner of the screen under “VIDEO INFORMATION.”

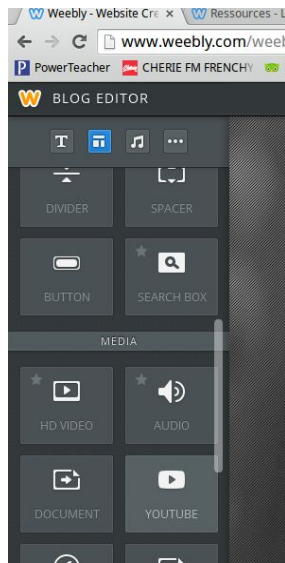


12. If your page still shows the blue “Publish” button, make sure to click that or your video will not actually be published.

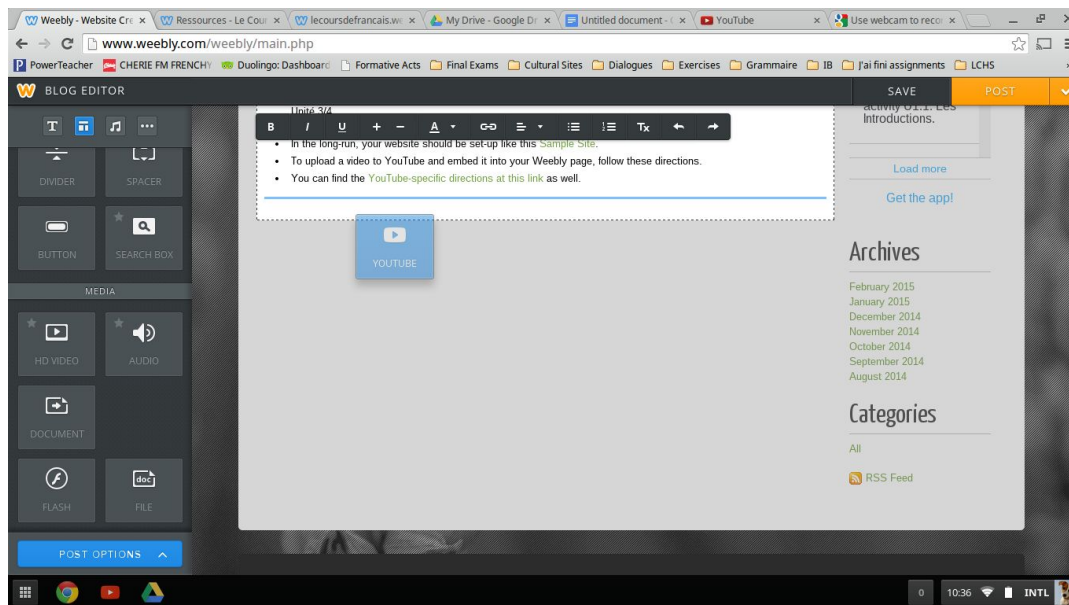
13. Copy your Video URL by highlighting the text in the Video URL box and click Ctrl + c.

14. To embed your Youtube video, go to your Weebly site and open up the page “Unité 1/ 2.”

15. On the left-hand menu, scroll down until you see the option “YOUTUBE.”



16. Click on the box and drag it to your page. Wherever the blue bar appears is where your “element” (Youtube) will be placed.





17. Click on the video element ONLY ONCE and a box should pop up. Paste your Video URL into the box and click anywhere outside of the box. If your video shows up in the box, you are done!
