



How to set up your Weebly account (French 2+)


1. Log in to your Weebly account. If you forgot your username and password, Mme Probst has that information.
2. Select “Edit Site”




3. Select “Pages” from the top menu.



4. Add a page by clicking the + next to PAGES.




5. Select “Standard Page” and title your page “Français I.” Click “Save.”




6. Combine all of your French 1 pages by dragging each one so that it is below the page "Français I," but aligned just to the right. **DO NOT DO THIS FOR THE PAGE "MON BLOG."**


Your pages should be organized as shown in the right-hand picture.




7. Return to the BUILD function by selecting BUILD from the top menu.



8. Go to the “Accueil” page. Hover over the text box that includes your table of contents from French 1. Click on the arrow in the top-left corner of the text box.



9. Select “Move” and click on the page “FRANCAIS I.” This moves the text box to your Français I page, so you have your table of contents in the correct place. Do the same with the title “LE COURS DE FRANÇAIS I”



10. Return to the Accueil page and add a new title: "Le Cours de Français II" and copy the table of contents located on my sample site.
